S.R.O 201(I)/2004.—In exercise of powers conferred by section 40 the Privatisation Commission Ordinance, 2000 (LII of 2000), read with section 39 thereof the Privatisation Commission, with the approval of the Federal Government, makes the following rules, namely:—

THE PRIVATISATION COMMISSION

(DECLARATION OF FIDELITY AND SECRECY) RULES, 2003

Preliminary

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Privatisation Commission (Declaration of Fidelity and Secrecy) Rules, 2003.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. **Definitions.**—(1) In these rules, unless there is any thing repugnant in the subject or context,—

(a) "fidelity" means compliance with the Ordinance and rules and regulations made thereunder; and

(b) "Ordinance" means the Privatisation Commission Ordinance, 2000 (LII of 2000).

(2) All terms and expressions used, but not defined in these rules, shall

3. **Declaration of fidelity and secrecy.**—The Chairman, Secretary, members, consultants, officers and other employees of the Commission including civil servants on deputation to the Commission shall make declaration of fidelity and secrecy in the form set out in the schedule and shall abide by the declaration so made.

4. **Violation of declaration of fidelity and secrecy.**—(1) Any person who violates the declaration of fidelity and secrecy shall be guilty of misconduct and shall be dealt with in accordance with the Privatisation Commission (Terms and Conditions of Appointment) Regulations, 2002 and other regulations notified from time to time:

Provided that the civil servants appointed to the Commission shall be governed by the Civil Servants Act, 1973 (LXXI of 1973), and rules made thereunder.
