INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (“EOI”) FOR PANEL OF ADVOCATES

Section 5 (m) of the Privatisation Commission Ordinance, 2000 (“**Ordinance**”) empowers the Privatisation Commission (“**Commission**”) to appoint lawyers, on such terms and conditions as the Commission may determine, to discharge its functions, under the Ordinance. The existing panel of lawyers of the Commission is being enhanced, in accordance with the foregoing terms and conditions.

EOIs from well reputed lawyers are requested for submission. The requisite criteria, to be included in Commission’s panel of lawyers, is as follows:

- i. The applicant must have been licensed to practice law, for a minimum period of ten (10) years, within the territorial jurisdiction of Pakistan, prior to the submission of the EOI.
- ii. The applicant must have a valid license to practice law in either the High Court or the Supreme Court of Pakistan.
- iii. The applicant must have at least five (5) years of experience in commercial and corporate litigation.
- iv. The applicant must have at least five (5) reported High Court Judgments relating to interpretation of any commercial law.
- v. The aforementioned reported judgments should be as the lead lawyer/counsel and not as an associate lawyer.
- vi. Applicants with experience in mercantile, labour, corporate, privatisation and service law will be preferred.
- vii. The applicant should be listed on the relevant “Bar Association.”
